We helped fix the car of the single mother. She was able to get to work. We also helped to bring her utilities up to date. I confirmed the local plant was downsizing, and the husband after being with the company for over 20 years was laid off because they are outsourcing many jobs overseas. I again question what has happened to the American jobs, the American dream. When I first talked to this gentleman, he was extremely upset and hurt. I explained to him that there was no way the company he was working for could compete with factories overseas that utilize cheap labor and incomprehensible working conditions. He admitted the company he worked for held on as long as possible. They just could not compete against the global economy.
