- MY MISSION-

I have devoted myself to help those in need.

I grew up and out of moments of poverty through perseverance and hard work. Because I have personally experienced what it is like to be in need, I made a vow to God long ago to diligently work to help those who are extremely poverty stricken—focusing on children, elderly, the handicapped, those that cannot fend for themselves. I also help families, widows, single moms, good people who have fallen on hard times.

To date, I have helped an average of 500 extremely poverty-stricken and good fellow creations per year for the past 28 years. We provide over 20,000 pounds of food per month. Sad but true, there are over 40 million Americans who go to bed hungry every night. We have provided thousands of blankets, hundreds of heaters, thousands of coats, shoes, gloves, and hats. We have provided tens of thousands of diapers, toiletries (toilet paper, soap, toothpaste, tooth brushes, etc.) We have supplied air-conditioners for those with heart problems and other extreme health conditions where heat and humidity can be terminal. I have turned on electricity when we find people sitting in the dark. I have the heat turned on when I find people suffering in the cold. I have also provided hundreds of toys, educational tools, books, etc... to children that have none. I have provided shelter, refurbished run down homes, helped to provide jobs, etc., whatever God puts upon my heart to help my fellow creations.

Since I grew up in moments of poverty, I know how it feels to be fearfully sad. I know how it feels to watch your mother cry when the electricity is turned off and you have no food. I vowed to God that I would always work hard and provide for my mission with devotion and dedication.

I used to provide all the funding for the Time Is Now; however, I have been unable to financially assist all those in need who have turned to me for help. After much encouragement, I now share my mission of helping with others who wish to help by **Caring and Sharing**. Good, God loving people have come to the calling, helping our neighbors in need.

There are several other individuals who have joined forces to provide support in any way they can. There are some heartfelt doctors, devoted attorneys, business organizations, and a group of friends, relatives, and most of all *concerned citizens* who know that any amount donated means a lot to those without. Others, who have been greatly blessed financially through their hard work, understand caring and sharing to help their fellow creations gives them life, no money can buy.

Any time I become discouraged at work, I call to mind all of these children and elderly who are in extreme need. Their plight drives me to work even harder to achieve goals that will help the extremely poverty stricken.

Every cent you donate will go directly to help the needy, 100%. For the past 28 years, I have funded all of The Time Is Now's operating expenses through my other business, from corporate fees right down to postage stamps. Our continuing goal is to direct every cent donated to "The Time is Now to Help", to remove the pain and suffering of poverty by providing food, shelter assistance, clothing, utility assistance, toiletries, household necessities, transportation...to give hope to the extremely poverty-stricken.

I have personally never taken one penny out of The Time Is Now. Quoting Article Two of our Articles of Incorporation, "No part of any of the monies of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its officers or directors; there are no directors' fees, no directors' salaries, no auto expenses, and no reimbursements..."

My promise to God drives me. The good book says, "Those who help the least of My people, helps Me." I find those who need help by my own investigation and letters written in for help. I also get referrals from schools, social workers, churches of all denominations, and concerned neighbors. I research each situation for genuine need. I alone cannot provide all that is needed for so many suffering we have located. Thank you very much for your time and consideration of help.
