THIS IS HOW ALL OF US HELPED:

RENT/SHELTER = \$13,954.29

Paul Ziegler and all of "You" helped us to prevent homelessness for senior citizens, the disabled, single mothers and working poor families. Over thirty people were provided shelter assistance thanks to your donations matched by the Paul Ziegler \$15,000 Matching Grant. The handicapped, senior citizens, single mothers and children, working poor families, were all provided much needed rent assistance. Again, we provided emergency shelter in motels for single mothers and children in desperate need. The stress and pain of impending homelessness was relieved for these fellow creations turning to us in need, thanks to all of “You” and the Paul Ziegler \$15,000 Matching Grant. Many cried tears of gratitude for continued shelter and removing the fear of becoming homeless. God Bless all of “You” and Paul Ziegler for causing these tears of thankfulness.

UTILITIES = Gas: \$5,900.00

Gas utilities were a struggle to pay this winter. Many are on the verge of disconnection this coming April 15th. Thanks to all of “You” and Paul Ziegler we were able to prevent this disconnection from being a reality for many of our fellow American’s. Senior citizens were able to keep their heat at a comfortable level and children did not have to wear their coats indoors as parents worried about the large utility bills due to the extreme cold we have all endured this winter. What a blessing to have “You” and the Paul Ziegler \$15,000 Matching Grant there to provide this much needed utility assistance.

FOOD = \$1,054.51

Your donations, matched by the Paul Ziegler \$15,000 Matching Grant, provided emergency food assistance with gift cards. Emergency food assistance is a big part of our mission to provide much needed food and nourishment to our senior citizens, handicapped and children. Healthy vegetables, protein and fruit are a luxury for those struggling to get by on minimum

wage or living on social security. These foods should be a staple in everyone's life. Many of our seniors are struggling with health concerns that require them to eat a healthy diet, yet all they can afford are cheap carbohydrates that are empty calories and have no nutritional basis. "Your" donations helped to provide these healthy foods to those that need them most, the elderly, children and the handicapped.

TRANSPORTATION = \$8,723.70

Our car ministry continues to be an important area for assistance. Five people were provided with much needed repairs for their vehicles. Together "We" also purchased a handicap accessible van with wheel chair lift for a fellow creation that has been waiting for this assistance for some time. We also were able to register a donated car for one of our clients that have been waiting for a car to be donated. Thank you to the donor of that car. You have given this person the opportunity to keep their employment. Thank you to all of "You" and Paul Ziegler for providing the funds needed to repair cars to good working order to maintain employment. We also provided much needed gas gift cards to many in need of this assistance.

DENTAL CARE: \$367.50

Dental care continues to be a luxury for our fellow creations. Lack of dental care causes unbelievable pain and health complications for many. We have alleviated this pain for one of our fellow creations that was struggling in pain while in desperate need of oral surgery. One of our wonderful local oral surgeons provided a generous donation of their time and talent for a desperately needed procedure. We provided a small sum towards the total amount of work needed to relieve this woman of her excruciating pain. Thank you to all of "You" and Paul Ziegler for making all of our good works possible.
