This sweet woman has been through so much, the death of her only son a few years ago and then the death of her husband six months ago. She had no savings as she had used every penny of it to care for her ailing son and then husband when he went into heart failure. She is finally coming out of her intense grief and seems ready to move on with her life once again. We would be so grateful if you could be the catalyst she needs to move out of the homeless shelter and into her own apartment. We met the following day in the parking lot of a local church. As it was a weekday afternoon the lot was empty, and we were able to sit outside and enjoy the beautiful weather. Both women were very cordial, and we soon found ourselves speaking like old friends.

The first subject we discussed was the homeless woman's past and how she became homeless. The years of medical expenses and inability to work as the full-time care for both her son and then her husband had taken all her time and energy. The homeless woman still carried a great grief but shared she is now ready to try and live on her own. She was excited to start her new job and had joined a church and one of its grief support groups. These were all steps in the right direction.

We went over her budget and put together a plan to keep her on course. The woman vehemently stated she never wanted to go through being homeless again, and I knew she

meant it. With our helping hand up with two months rent, a security deposit, a new bed, gift cards for household necessities and other items she would need to make her apartment a home, she would be well on her way to a new start. I added additional gift cards for new clothing for her job and for food, as this expense continues to be almost out of reach for so many in our communities.

Both women hugged each other and shared happy tears of relief for the future we made possible for this previously homeless woman. Her life would change in so many ways thanks to her hard work and determination, matched by all our hard work and determination that wants to see our fellow creations succeed.
